CHM ZAMBIA

In our October 2016 edition, we reported that CHM received a message in the U.K. from Revd Chilekwa Mulenga in Zambia about our work with the sick. He had visited our website and read about the wonders The Lord is performing through CHM and was moved enough to make contact with us. The message centred around enquiries about the establishment of CHM in Zambia.

Following deliberation and careful prayerful consideration by the management of CHM UK, we are delighted to report that on the 22nd of June 2017, Revd Sam Ajibola, the President of CHM international travelled to Ndola, Zambia in Southern Africa to meet Revd Mulenga and his colleagues. The president was very warmly welcomed and given a taste of Zambian hospitality. The meeting turned out to be a meeting of like minds and he was able to see first-hand the amazing efforts that had gone into bringing the meeting into fruition.

On the 24th of June, the first full day of his visit, Revd Ajibola attended a seminar where he ministered to over 70 delegates drawn from different denominations in Ndola. The seminar took place at the School of Biomedical Sciences of Ndola Teaching Hospital. On the 2nd day of his visit, on the invitation of Pastor Malala Zulu, he ministered in the morning service at Pentecostal Assemblies of God Church to a congregation of about 150. After the service, Revd Ajibola joined the local hospital ministry volunteers to visit Ndola Teaching Hospital, a 2500 bed hospital, where they prayed for one hundred and ninety five patients eighteen of whom gave their lives to Christ. In addition, four of those prayed for testified to God's miraculous healing.

Revd Mulenga, the chief host in Zambia, serves as the hospital chaplain of Ndola Teaching Hospital, a role which provides him a very good opportunity to cater for the spiritual needs of the patients.

At the end of Revd Ajibola's visit, the volunteers in Ndola expressed the need for further training in future to help them function better in their role as CHM volunteers.

He espoused the famous teachings of Christ in Mark 16:17-18 where He commissioned all believers to heal the sick. The training ended with a time of ministration and prayer for all the participants led by Revd Ajibola.
